**You will need to provide the following items for tax-aid assistance.
Some items may not apply to you.**

- Photo ID
- Name and address
- Social security card
- Daycare provider name, address and social security number (or employer ID number)
- Children's birth dates, social security cards, income statements, health insurance info
- 2016 tax return, if possible
- Statements showing all income, such as W-2 forms, 1099s, Social Security, dividends
- Information about health insurance (including Form 1095), college tuition paid, Alaska Native Corporation dividend, energy saving improvements
- If you itemize deductions: property tax paid, mortgage interest paid, charitable donations, health insurance premiums, non-reimbursed medical payments

Please Note: Your tax return **CANNOT BE COMPLETED** without your picture ID and Social Security card or paperwork from Social Security for **ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR FAMILY**. Both spouses **MUST** sign joint returns.
